

# Student Trustee



## Description

As a student trustee you become a member of the board that is responsible for overseeing all of the administration and management of the Union. You are responsible for the governance and budget of the Union, and as a board delegate responsibilities to other Union committees, such as Council and Finance Committee. As an officer with oversight of all Union activities, you are also responsible for all Union activities and will be able to review any relevant activity in the best interests of the organisation.

## Duties & Responsibilities

- To help UCLU achieve its objectives and improve the lives of its members.
- To ensure that UCLU acts in accordance with its constitution and other guiding documents and in particular that it remains true to its mission, vision and values.
- To use their personal skills and experience to ensure UCLU is well-run and efficient.

## Who is Eligible to Stand?

All UCL Students, however, Student Trustees may not hold any other position within the Union's democratic structure, excluding on the committees of clubs and societies.

## Time Commitment

Term of office for 1 year, until 1 November:

- A few hours will need to be set aside for reading papers in advance of each meeting
